How to cut our antislip decking

Marley's antislip range is designed to be robust and hard wearing. Due to the durable nature of our antislip resin/aggregate insert we recommend following our instructions when cutting our antislip deck boards.

- ▲ At the required point of cutting; mark a straight line across the boards.
- Use a 125mm angle grinder, with either a 3 or 5mm thick cutting disc (stone or steel work equally the same) to cut through the resin/aggregate insert.
- ▲ Use a hand or mechanical timber saw to cut the remaining timber.
- Any exposed surfaces should be given two liberal coats of a brush on end grain preservative, this includes cross cutting, notches and drill holes. This will maintain the integrity of the protection. Our recommended product is Protim Water Based end coat which is available in 1 litre tins.
