

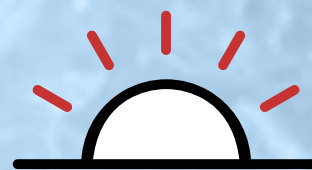
SUPPORTING THE ROOFER THIS WINTER

From battling icy conditions to sheltering from heavy rainfall, UK roofers are seeing significant impacts from changing winter weather conditions. In fact, 60% are experiencing increased delays to projects due to extreme winter weather.

1 MAXIMISE DAYLIGHT HOURS

Adjust schedules, start work early and prioritise daylight dependent tasks. Ensure enough time to collect tools and get to ground safely before light fades.



2 PROTECT AGAINST STRONG WINDS

Avoid working at height in winds over 20mph. Secure tools and materials when high winds are forecast.

3 GEAR UP FOR WINTER

Wear insulated clothing, headgear for extra warmth (such as liners for hard-hats), safety boots and winter gloves.

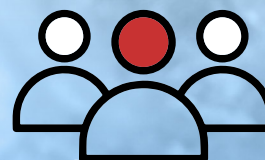


4 STAY SAFE ON SLIPPERY SURFACES

Clear snow and ice from roofs before starting work. In icy conditions begin work on the side of the roof facing the sun as it's likely to defrost quicker.

5 WEATHER SPECIFIC TOOLBOX TALKS

Tailor your toolbox talks to address weather-specific hazards, such as cold, rain, fog and snow, ensuring your crew is prepared to work safely in winter conditions.
